- Maximum 9 semester units in other academic work relevant to business and accounting (maximum 3 units from any one area)
  - Skills-based courses -Courses completed in the following disciplines: English, Communications,  $\circ$ Journalism, and the Physical, Life, Natural, & Social Sciences Foreign Languages/ Courses in foreign languages (including sign language) and courses with the 0 Cultural & Ethnic Studies terms culture, cultural, or ethnic in the titles
  - Industry-based courses -Courses with the words "industry" or "administration" in the title or courses 0 completed in the following disciplines: Engineering, Architecture, and Real Estate
- Maximum 4 semester units in internships/independent studies in accounting and/or business-related subjects
- Completion of a Master of Accounting, Taxation, or Laws in Taxation is equivalent to 20 semester units of accounting study
