ESSENTIAL CONSIDERATIONS FOR SUCCESSFUL INTERNSHIPS

A student enrolled in the Fullerton College Internship Program will work at your worksite as related to their major, while earning academic credit. These work-learn experiences require a number of hours of work for each academic credit earned starting at 60 hours per 1 unit credit for unpaid internship and 75 hours per 1 unit credit for paid internships. We will work with you to insure the best experience for you and the student intern.

- Availability of intern projects as matched to your workload/business cycle.
- Adequate support, including office space, staff support and financial resources.
- Job description, eligibility/application requirements, hours and compensation structures.
- Meaningful assignments that challenge the intern and provide value to you.
- Appropriate inclusion in organizational events, staff meetings or other business activities.
- On-the-job training opportunities with measurable learning objectives or evaluation.
- Appointment of a seasoned, supervisory staff member who values the intern investment.
